The early symptoms of ovarian cancer—which includes bloating, abdominal pain, weight gain and irregular urinary and bowel habits—also appear in other illnesses and are usually not considered life-threatening.

For this reason, ovarian cancer is often not detected until later stages making it difficult to treat.

At the same time there are many different types of ovarian cancer and current treatment methods don't effectively target these different strains.

As Dr Jim Coward explains, "Ovarian cancer refers to a number of different types of cancer of the ovary, each of which responds differently to chemotherapy."

"We aren't making any big strides in prolonging how long these patients live with this disease, because we're treating it as if it is a single disease entity, which it is not.

"The idea of this research is to investigate new ways of treating particular strains of ovarian cancers, using a more specialised treatment approach.

"Adopting a personalised, targeted strategy for each type of ovarian cancer is the only way we can try to improve overall survival."
